

DenyAll delivers key milestone in Next Generation WAF roadmap

DenyAll shipped new versions of its core products, including version 6.1 of its Next Generation WAF platform, which embeds key innovations such as User Reputation Scoring and threat intelligence from DenyAll IP Reputation Service. The next milestone is on target for delivery within 6 months and will feature security engines ported from DenyAll rWeb.

DenyAll announces the general availability of new versions of its entire line of Web Application Firewalls (WAFs):

- **Version 6.1** of DenyAll **Web Application Firewall (WAF)**, DenyAll **Web Services Firewall (WSF)** and DenyAll **Web Access Manager (WAM)**, is the latest version of the company's Next Generation WAF platform and last version supported (LVS) for these products;
- **Version 5.5.9** of DenyAll **i-Suite** is the latest update to the long term support (LTS) version of the related products, which are recommended to be used in production environments;
- **Version 4.2.1** of DenyAll **rWeb** is the latest update to the LTS version of the related products, including sProxy and the DenyAll rWeb Management Console, which customers should update their production environments to;

DenyAll **Cloud Protector**, the company's WAF-as-a-Service, was also updated recently to provide more granular exception management capabilities. It will continue to evolve in the coming weeks to deliver more value to small businesses and large organizations looking to secure their shadow IT.

Major innovations embedded in Next Generation WAF

Version 6.1 of DenyAll WAF, WSF and WAM embed a number of new features on top of the changes that were implemented in version 6.0 at the end of 2015:

- **User Reputation Scoring:** new workflow bricks provide the ability to track users over time, evaluate their behavior in context and programmatically define the adequate response to a changing user reputation score;
- **IP Reputation Scoring:** workflows can now use the reputation score and/or category provided by the **DenyAll IP Reputation Service** to define how requests coming from questionable IP addresses should be handled;
- **Common Application Security:** this application fingerprinting wizard automatically discovers the nature of the application and suggests an ad hoc security policy. Templates are available for popular Content Management Systems (WordPress, Drupal, Joomla, etc) and Microsoft products (Outlook Web Access, SharePoint 2010 & 2013). More will be added over time;
- **Monitoring & Reporting:** enhancements to the web-based capabilities introduced in version 6.0 provide the ability to manipulate more performance and security indicators;
- **Text User Interface:** makes the initial setup of appliances easier.

“User Reputation Scoring introduces a fundamental paradigm shift for WAFs, from traditional, request-by-request filtering to the ability to respond programmatically to changing user behaviors”, says Stéphane de Saint Albin, DenyAll CMO. ***“Our Next Generation WAF’s ability to monitor user behavior over time, to evaluate their trustworthiness and to define automated response scenarios will change the perceived value of WAFs for organizations”***.

Next milestones

The next iteration of the platform, version 6.2, will bring many additional features, including the integration of DenyAll rWeb's core security engines. That version is scheduled for delivery at the end of the summer.
