

The Cybersecurity Summit in Paris on May 31st marked a new page in the 17-year history of DenyAll

The star of the day was the **R&S®Web Application Firewall 6.5** (Long Term Support Version) that was introduced via a number of workshops to display its enhanced capabilities, notably the new functions of bot mitigation and analytics. The roadmap for R&S®Cloud Protector, the company's cloud native Web & API protection service, was another highlight at the Summit.

Finally, **Mr Reik Hesselbarth**, Managing Director and CFO of Rohde & Schwarz Cybersecurity, took the opportunity to announce **the appointment of Stéphane de Saint Albin as the leader of the newly formed Application and Cloud Security business unit.** This organizational change is effective as of June 1, 2018. Mr de Saint Albin has served as VP Marketing and Business Development of DenyAll from 2011 to 2017 and currently serves as VP Product Strategy of Rohde & Schwarz Cybersecurity.
